Help Life would like to invite the applications of physically challenged girl students* only from across India- irrespective of caste or creed for a scholarship award of Rs. 50,000.

To be able to enrol for this award you need to submit the mentioned documents and fulfil the criteria mentioned:

- Disability certificate (attested copy) to be submitted along with a full length photograph displaying disability.

Minimum Qualification:

- Graduate with aggregate score of 65% and above.

Or

- Diploma holder (10th std+ 4 years) with an aggregate score of 65% and above + 1 year of work experience.

Attested copies of 10th, 12th, Degree mark sheets + leaving certificate / Attested copies of 10th, Diploma market, Work experience certificate + leaving certificate.

Extra-curricular Talent:

- A video clip of the performance and/ or certificates (singing, dance, playing musical instruments, scans of paintings)

This may be loaded onto a CD and couriered with the documents or the clip may be emailed to us.

Economic Background:

- Opportunities will be given to those Below the Poverty Line

Ration card copy and income certificate to be submitted duly attested.

Statement of Intent:

- To be submitted in your mother tongue language- stating a brief write up about yourself, your aim, career goal, your achievements, skills/competencies and your aspirations.

This may be handwritten or typed.

Extra Credit:

- Community service/involvement (Do you contribute to making a difference to someone?)

Evidence to be submitted (photographs + certificate of volunteering)

References:

The applicant must provide the email address/ phone numbers of any two individuals who can provide recommendation/ references for the applicant. (The two referees should not be from the applicant's family)

Terms and conditions:

***The girl must be an Indian.**

****Documents to be attested and sent by speed post to the Help Life office.**

Any discrepancy in documentation + references will automatically disqualify the application.
